

ProQuest Platform Updates

Changes to My Research Authentication

- From 1st August users need to use their **email address** (*not* their username) and their existing password to authenticate into My Research (My Research)
- We now have a 1:1 relationship between an email address and a My Research account
 - It is no longer possible to have the same email address linked to multiple My Research accounts
- No other My Research functionality is impacted
- *House of Commons Parliamentary Papers* has gone through the same change too







Abstract

Wafer-level integration of 2D transition metal disulfide is the key factor for future large-scale integration of the continuously scaling down devices, and has attracted great attention in recent years. Compared with other ultra-thin film growth methods, atomic layer deposition (ALD) has the advantages of excellent step coverage, uniformity and thickness controllability. In this work, we synthesized large-scale and thickness-controllable MoS₂ films on sapphire substrate by ALD at 150 °C with molybdenum hexacarbonyl and hexamethyldisilathiane (HMDS) as precursors followed by high-temperature annealing in sulfur atmosphere. HMDS is introduced for the first time to enable a toxic-free process without hazardous sulfur precursors such as H₂S and CH₃SSCH₃. The synthesized MoS₂ retains the inherent benefits from the ALD process, including thickness controllability, reproducibility, wafer-level thickness uniformity, and high conformity. Finally, field-effect transistor (FET) arrays were fabricated based on the large-area ALD MoS₂ films. The top-gate FETs exhibited excellent electrical performance such as high on/off current ratio over 10⁶ and peak room-temperature mobility up to 11.56 cm² V⁻¹ s⁻¹. This work opens up an attractive approach to realize the application of high-quality 2D materials with wafer scale homogeneity.

1. Introduction

Nanoelectronic devices built on two-dimensional (2D) materials, such as molybdenum disulfide (MoS₂) [1] and other members of the transition metal dichalcogenides (TMDs) family, are emerging alternatives with high-mobility in the field of large-area and low-power electronics which is currently dominated by low-mobility amorphous silicon and organic semiconductors [2–4]. MoS₂ is a well-known TMD semiconductor and has been widely studied due to the promising applications in various fields including photonics [5–7], sensing [8], catalysis [9] and field-effect transistors (FETs) [10–13]. Most current experimental research rely on the MoS₂ films mechanically exfoliated from bulk material. Although the pristine MoS₂ has low concentration of structural defects and is ideal for making proof-of-concept devices, the flake size, thickness and location are largely uncontrollable, making it unsuitable for massive and homogeneous production. For example, monolayer MoS₂ FETs have been reported in 2011 exhibiting an excellent current on/off ratio of 10⁶ and high carrier mobility of ~200 cm² V⁻¹ s⁻¹ at room temperature [12]. Yet, such record high mobility strongly depends on the flake surface quality, making it hardly to reproduce homogeneous MoS₂ samples and FETs [14]. Thus, new strategies are to be developed for reproducible and scalable high-quality TMD thin films and devices.

Chemical vapor deposition (CVD)-based approaches are presently used to achieve high-quality monolayer and few-layer MoS₂ flakes [15–19]. The typical process relies on the reduction reactions between the S and MoO₃ source powders (other sources like MoCl₅ have also been reported). For example, Schmidt et al have successfully grown MoS₂ thin films by CVD method and fabricated back-gate FETs showing low-temperature mobility up to 500 cm² V⁻¹ s⁻¹ at 10 K [20]. Kang et al demonstrated the synthesis of MoS₂ monolayer with a high mobility of 30 cm² V⁻¹ s⁻¹ at room temperature using CVD with

Query Interpretation – Taxonomy Suggestions

- Makes suggestions to revise search for precision
 - Trigger is when the user input matches a heading from a given taxonomy
 - Taxonomy must be applicable to content within scope of user's search
 - Suggestion maximizes the levels of precision possible
- Also makes suggestions based on taxonomy "See" references
 - Redirects a match on a "see" reference/Use For term to heading
 - Same other conditions as above

- Feature to Support specialist researchers, particularly systematic reviewers
- Former syntax: Search Fields joined by commas
 - Throwback to Dialog-style searching
 - Example: TI,AB,SU(*term1 NEAR term2*) or similar
- Inefficient & hard on search architecture
 - Equivalent to the following: TI(*term1 NEAR term2*) OR AB(*term1 NEAR term2*) OR SU(*term1 NEAR term2*)
 - Saves typing but not load

 Rosalyn Terborg-Penn

We are sad to share the news of the passing of pioneering historian of African American women, Rosalyn Terborg-Penn. Professor Terborg-Penn wrote a pathbreaking 1977 dissertation that became her contribution to rethinking the place of Black women in the struggle for woman suffrage, *African American Women in the Struggle for the Vote, 1850-1920* (1998). In 2008, we approached Professor Terborg-Penn with a proposal to draw on her dissertation and book as the foundation for creating on WASM a primary source set on the writings of Black Women Suffragists. Professor Terborg-Penn graciously shared her work and joined the project, writing an introduction and leading our efforts to recruit 16 other noted historians to write scholarly essays that draw on the collection. We are deeply indebted to her and the Black Women Suffragists Collection has benefited enormously from her contributions. She was a good friend and a dedicated historian. She will be missed.




