Sherif-EBSCO Enhancement Group Chair's Report for Sherif Committee Meeting May 2022

Since my previous report (Feb 2022) the group has met once in April 2022. Draft minutes have recently been submitted for uploading to the group's webpage.

The agenda addressed a progress review of the enhancements currently in development in relation to EBSCO's eBook-related services including GOBI, EBSCOhost Collection Manager, EBSCO eBook licensing and the EBSCO mobile app. Progress in the availability of the promised enhancements were discussed by the group, following the detailed preview and feedback session we held with EBSCO in 2021.

The GOBI/Talis integration enhancement is still not live for institutions. Following the earlier discussion with EBSCO, further feedback on the proposed integration has been given by some member institutions. At the time of writing, I am awaiting an updated response from EBSCO on

an expected go-live date for the GOBI/Talis integration.

Enhancements which are now live include an improved EBSCOhost Collection Manager interface and license upgrades in ECM and Open Access monographs availability in GOBI for several major publishers to improve streamlining of workflows for OA content.

Further agenda items included issues raised by Sherif members via the Sherif email list and members of the group. These have been submitted to EBSCO to provide further emphasis to the existing support cases submitted directly by institutions. Issues & enhancement requests reported in response to email invitation via the mailing list remain at a low level, which has been the case since the pandemic began. Sector priorities such as the Elsevier negotiation and overall capacity issues for institutions may be driving the low level of engagement. Group members bring their own experience and knowledge of EBSCO's various products and services to the meeting, and there is a notable commonality of experience with some products which enables the group to provide feedback to EBSCO on issues which are likely to be also affecting other Sherif member institutions.
