


Users can export all their citations to a Tab Delimited format (.tsv) so they can view their citations in Excel.



PDF progress bar


Users can view multiple files uploading into RefWorks and then see the progress as RefWorks prepares the document for use in the reader.






Performance: PDF progress bar






Password Reset Workflow Improvements

experience.






Idea Exchange




Document Compatibility









Document Compatibility in Write-N-Cite (WNC)

Automatically detects a document with legacy RefWorks Citation IDs and when logged in to new RefWorks prompts the user to upgrade the document to new RefWorks Citation Format.



If the user isn't ready to upgrade the document they can login to legacy RefWorks.
Support links are at the footer.



If missing a reference, directions provide information to import missing legacy citations into new RefWorks or to proceed with using legacy RefWorks.


WnC Installation fixes (based on diagnostic)

Usage Analytics

New Admin report provides institutional usage stats for page views and visits/session. These reports can be displayed in either a Daily, Monthly or Custom view.




- **Pageview:** A pageview is an instance of a page being loaded (or reloaded) in a browser. Pageviews equals the total number of pages viewed.
- **Session**: A session is the period of time a user is active on the site, as a sequence of page views in a user visit to RefWorks.





Added a new form of deduplication similar to the method used in legacy RefWorks

- Minor fixes to deduplication
- Added 'Legacy' Close Match.
 - based on the Soundex phonetic algorithm.
 - method works best with English surnames and short titles"
- Changing the names: Exact Match, Close Match
- More work will be done on deduplication in H2 2018




MAY Release: GDPR

Regulation (GDPR) and new RefWorks and legacy RefWorks will be ready.






